Subject: Issuance of Letter of Intent for establishment of new technical institution (Degree Engineering & Technology) in the name & style of ST. VIYESENT PALLOTTI, COLLEGE OF ENGG. & TECH., GAUSHIMANAPUR, WARDHA ROAD, NAGPUR - 441 108, MAHARASHTRA, in the Academic year 2004-05.

Madam

This is with reference to your application submitted to the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for establishment of a new Technical Institution under the name and style ST. VIYESENT PALLOTTI, COLLEGE OF ENGG. & TECH., GAUSHIMANAPUR, WARDHA ROAD, NAGPUR - 441 108, MAHARASHTRA, in the academic year 2004-2005.

I am directed to convey the decision of the Council to issue the Letter of Intent (LOI) for establishment of new technical institution (Degree Engineering & Technology) in the name & style of ST. VIYESENT PALLOTTI, COLLEGE OF ENGG. & TECH., GAUSHIMANAPUR, WARDHA ROAD, NAGPUR - 441 108, MAHARASHTRA., based on the recommendations on the Hearing Committee, Regional Committee and EC-Sub Committee, which examined your proposal as per the laid down procedure, guidelines, policy and norms & standards of AICTE.

To facilitate further processing of the proposal, you are now requested to furnish the following documents in one lot to the concerned Regional Office of AICTE, on or before 20<sup>th</sup> February 2004.

A non-refundable inspection fee of Rs.50,000/- in the form of a Bank Draft drawn on an Nationalized / Scheduled Bank in favour of the Member Secretary, AICTE, payable at New Delhi.

A Cumulative Fixed Deposit in a Nationalized / Scheduled Bank, in the joint name of Trust Society and the concerned Regional Office, for a period of 10 years for the amount as applicable to the category of the institutions indicated below:

The FDR should be created after obtaining the signature of the concerned Regional Officer of AICTE on the FDR application form of the concerned Bank. The Procedure for creation of the FDR is given Annexure I. The FDR should be created only in the Branch for which the signature of the concerned Regional Officer is obtained. An undertaking from the concerned Bank shall be submitted along with the FDR, as per format enclosed (Form A).

If the proposed institution is being set up by Central Government/State Government/University/Deemed University, the requirement of Joint Fixed Deposit and Inspection Fee will be exempted provided the courses are NOT self financing.

If any of the above requirements is not fulfilled, the proposal shall not be eligible for further processing for approval and shall stand rejected. The Council will not entertain any request for relaxation in the cut off date due to any reason, whatsoever.

If all the conditions mentioned above are fulfilled by the cut-off-date, visit of an AICTE Expert Committee will be arranged by AICTE, New Delhi during March 1, 2004 to April 30, 2004 for verification of all the facilities created for establishment of new Institution.

The Visiting Expert Committee will ensure that all the necessary infrastructural facilities for the proposed Institution, as indicated below, have been created, as per Norms of AICTE.

1. The land of the proposed Institution have been fully developed with clear demarcations, either by a boundary wall/ barbed wire fencing and an all weather approach road to the Institution built.
2. Building is complete in all respects including plastering, internal electrification, etc., at least adequate for first year of the programme, as stipulated by AICTE.
3. Adequate potable water is available.
4. Permanent electrical connection must be obtained.
5. All the required furniture and fixtures are in place as per requirements.
6. Books and Journals, as per Norms and Standards, have been procured and entered in the Accession Register.
7. Equipment, as per syllabus of first year, have been procured and are in operational stage.
8. Director/ Principal have been appointed, and Faculty as per AICTE norms identified and consent for joining the institution obtained.



16. Cash Book of the Society / Trust.
17. Copy of the advertisement for recruitment of faculty.
18. Composition of Selection Committee.

19. Architectural Drawings of building -construction duly prepared by an Architect and approved by the concerned statutory authority.
20. Master Plan of the Campus for the entire land indicating land-use, circulation, landscaping, infrastructure etc.
21. Floor Plans, Sections and Elevations of all the existing Academic buildings including Area details.
22. Letter of appointment /Offer Letter issued to faculty.
23. List of faculty appointed/identified with qualification and experience.
24. Joining report / consent of faculty members.
25. One page Bio-data of Principal/Director.
26. Acquaintance Register.
27. Fund position/Original FDR and Bank Certificate/ Statement.
28. Phase-wise plan of construction.
29. Cash Flow statement for next two years for the proposed Institution showing projected expenses and sources of fund, as indicated in DPR.
30. Audited statement of accounts of the Society /Trust.
31. Photographs (color) of the building attested by the Chairman/ Secretary of the Trust/Society and a Video CD (Compatible with "Windows Media Player") indicating the following:

The Expert Committee report shall be processed as per the approved Approval Process and the final decision for grant of approval or otherwise shall be communicated to all concerned by AICTE on or before May 15, 2004.

The applicant Trust / Society is hereby informed that issuance of LOI by AICTE does not entitle it automatic grant of final Approval. The proposed institution cannot commence any educational activity and admit students based on LOI.


The approval accorded above is subject to fulfillment of the following Conditions:

1. The institution must appoint Principal and other faculty members as per AICTE Norms with pay scales as prescribed by AICTE, before making any admission.
2. The institution must have Affiliation to a University for the above courses before making admissions. In the absence of such Affiliation, this Letter of approval shall be treated as Withdrawn. (Order of the High Court of Madras in W.P. No. 33256 of 2002 and other Batch of Petitions).
3. No admission shall be made by the institution, contrary to the guidelines issued by AICTE, for the academic session 2004-2005. All the admissions must necessarily be made through Entrance Test.
4. All the required Laboratories/ Workshops/ Machineries/ Equipment, as per approved syllabi of the affiliating University, must be operational before making admissions.
5. The approved course(s) shall commence as per the academic calendar of the Affiliating University.
6. If this Letter of approval is received by you after the closing date of State / National Level Central Counseling for Admissions in the concerned State / Union Territory, this Letter of approval shall not be valid for making any admission, and shall be treated as withdrawn.
7. No excess admission shall be made by the Institution during any academic year.
8. The approval is valid only for the academic year 2004-2005. This Approval Letter will not be valid for making any admission for the subsequent years.
9. In exercise of power conferred under 10(p) of the AICTE Act, AICTE, may inspect the Institution any time it may deem fit to verify the progress/ compliance or for any other purpose.
10. Any other condition(s) as may be specified by AICTE from time to time.
11. Consequent to the Supreme Court Judgment the Model Constitution of Governing Body as notified by AICTE in its approval Regulations 1994, stands overruled. "It has been decided that while AICTE will not insist of any nomination in the Governing Body of Private unaided Institutions, the Affiliating University/ State Government shall impose minimum condition of affiliation, such as, prescription of qualification of governing body members, in order to ensure academic excellence. The condition so imposed will be subjected to scrutiny by AICTE, wherever necessary, to ensure that the same are not unreasonable restrictions."

"It shall be desirable for the private unaided institutions to induct atleast 50% of members of the Governing Body drawn from renowned academia, academic administrators, subject field experts and a professionals from industry in order to seek their innovative ideas for continuous improvement in the delivery of teaching learning process, matching best practice elsewhere and achieve excellence."


In the event of infringement/ contravention or non-compliance of the above Conditions and/or the provision of AICTE Act & Regulations/ Guidelines/ Norms & Standards as prescribed by AICTE, further actions leading to "Reduced Intake" or "No Admission" or "Withdrawal of Approval" shall be taken by AICTE and the liability arising out of such actions will be solely that of the Management/ Trust/ Society and/ or the Institution.
