MINUTES OF MEETING

College IQAC meeting held on 13th February 2021 at 10:00 am. This meeting was conducted on Google Meet Platform. Dr. Surendra V Gole, Principal of college opened meeting by welcoming all committee members. He briefed meeting with the several agendas of meeting.

1. Minutes of last IQAC meeting -

Dr. (Mrs.) J. P. Rothe started her presentation giving minutes of last IQAC meeting conducted on 08th March 2020. She also presented review of the last meeting.

Dr. S. V. Gole asked members about confirming minutes of meeting and Dr. D. J. Tidke confirmed on this.

2. Action taken report –
