An Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Meet was conducted on 01st February 2024.

- Dr. Surendra Gole welcomed all IQAC members.
- Dr. Tarwatkar read the minutes of the previous meeting conducted on 23rd November 2023.
- Dr. Tidke proposed the confirmation of minutes which are seconded by Dr. N. V. Deshpande. Then the IQAC approved & confirmed the minutes of the meeting. After confirmation, Dr. Tarwatkar presented the action taken report.
- Dr. M. V. Aware presented Highlights of the academic activities of the Institute.
- Dr. Sachin Nagmote presented Highlights of the Co-curricular & Extracurricular activities of the Institute.
- Prof. H. Nagpure presented the highlights of the participation of team SAE in the national event.
- Dr. Minhaj A. Rehman presented the faculty activities and achievements report including a report on Research and Development Cell.
- Dr. Kishor Borakhade presented the Highlights of the Career Development Cell activities.

- Dr. Gaurav Gadge read the alumni cell activities.
- Dr. M. Bramhe presented the data for the III cell.
- Dr. S. V. Gole requested the members to provide their views and suggestions to improve the quality of the institute's activities and processes.

Suggestions / Remarks by Prof. Hemant Diddee:

- He appreciated the number of patents granted during this session. He further suggested developing these patents/ projects on a commercial scale.
- He showed concern for the number of students passing the aptitude tests during the comparatively low placement drive. He suggested that subsequent efforts be taken to improve the aptitude of the students.
- He further suggested that the internship selection ratio be improved as the number of students opting for on-campus as well as off-campus internships is low.

Suggestions / Remarks by Mr. Sandeep Darwhekar:

- He expressed that ability to do things can be enhanced which can be done through skill development and internships.
- He further suggested students should start working from the ground level to the finished product upgrading their skill set.
- To identify a generalized skillset that every engineer should acquire during his graduation.

Suggestions / Remarks by Prof. Aniruddha Bodhankar:

- He suggested focusing on improvement in placement as it directly impacts admissions (in core branches).
- He also suggested upon commercialization of patents.
- He further suggested working on the NIRF ranking so that the institute stands in the top 200 NIRF Institutes.
- For this, the number of research papers published can be increased.

Suggestions/ Remarks by Dr. D. J. Tidke:

- He expressed that there should be a motivational change in the overall activities and performance of the institute.

- He suggested that the faculty members must be charged up.
- He suggested institute should work on interaction with industries to improve the consultancy parameter.
- He further suggested that domain-specific subjects can be added to the curriculum.

Suggestions / Remarks by Fr. James Thomas:

- He suggested the new curriculum can be framed taking into consideration the ground reality of the domain-specific courses.
- The gap should be bridged between the CDC skillset requirement and the academics.

Suggestions / Remarks by Dr. M.V. Aware:

- He emphasized industry-institute interaction where the required skills of the industries can be covered in the curriculum.
- He further suggested maximum input can be delivered either by the industry people or the faculty members trained in the specific companies.

Dr. Surendra Gole thanked all IQAC members & invitees for their suggestions & meeting was concluded at 1.00 pm.
